HIGGOTT-KANE TO SILENCE EXHAUST AT PERU POWER PLANT

ATCO Division Delivers Proprietary Equipment to Kallpa Project

Higgott-Kane, a Division of ATCO Noise Management, has been awarded a contract to deliver its proprietary exhaust silencing system to achieve the demanding noise reduction targets at a new power plant in Kallpa, Peru.

The contract from Siemens Power Generation, Inc., allows Higgott-Kane to provide silencing for the plant's Siemens 501FD2 combustion turbine while also creating local employment for both manufacturing and installation.

The company's experience and reputation for quality ensures the new power generation station will be a quiet addition to the region. The 90-ft exhaust stack system will be fabricated at a local company operating out of Peru. Installation will be performed by local work crews.

An additional component of the exhaust silencing system will be fabricated in Monterrey, Mexico. Project Managers from Higgott-Kane will supervise all activities.

ATCO Noise Management President Boris Rassin said global projects such as Kallpa highlight the confidence clients have in ATCO's ability to deliver excellence in a variety of world markets.

The site for Kallpa is located in the town of Chilca, 62 km south of Lima. Plant construction will be completed in two stages; the first will bring 168 MW of power on-line and the second will increase power to 336 MW. The plant will be fueled by the Camisea field, Peru's largest natural gas reserve, and will help the nation reach its goal toward changing the country's energy mix. Plant operation is scheduled to begin in June, 2007.
